Please staple your blueprints/plans, etc with measurements and other details to this package for approval. The instructor may deny your proposal package if requirements are not met or if class behavior is an issue.

If you have completed this package and acquired parental/guardian permission the instructor may still say no or stop the project at any time. Parents/guardians will be notified immediately if any issues arise.
