This activity is meant to expose students to creative ways to make money with metal/trades by looking at the world and career options around you. Taking the skills you learn and transforming them into a way to have fun as a hobby or to make money is an option for finding your pathway in life.

- Research a metal artist, jewelry maker, fabricator/trades-person that makes things you like! <u>Pick one related to your interests!</u>.
  Where are they located? What do they specialize in? Do they give tutorials or just sell their items?
- 2. Try and figure out the process they take for ONE (or more) of their projects and write them out in your google doc. You can also use photos/
  - Build procedures, design work, etc, to get to their final product
  - Do they need fancy tools or can a lot be done with basic tools or something you can get from a Dollar store!
- 3. You should try and go as in depth as you can and include as much information as you think is useful.
- 4. This is not a quick report. You may take your time to come up with something that interests you and something that you may want to take on and try to build in the shop.
